The world has changed steadily over the centuries as inventions connected with travel such as the train, the car, and the airplane, have made vast differences, not only to the ways in which people travel, but also to almost every other aspect of human life. The next invention to bring great changes will perhaps be the self-driving car.

The self-driving car, also known as the "driverless car" or "autonomous car," makes use of modern technology to travel automatically between two places without any human control. The person in the car simply sets the required destination and leaves the rest to the car's technology. This technology includes software to calculate a route, radar-like devices to measure the distance from objects such as other cars, and automatic braking and steering systems developed with artificial intelligence. The person in the car doesn't need to do anything at all, except to sit back and enjoy the ride, although the technology usually has the function of allowing him or her to take over driving if necessary.

At present, self-driving vehicles, not necessarily cars, are already in

use on construction sites and other industrial environments. In the United States, there are some cities where self-driving cars are used as taxis, although this is still in the testing stage. The technology is continually being improved. It is expected that the use of self-driving cars will become more common in the next decade.

Although people have many concerns about self-driving cars, there is no doubt that their impact will be huge. If they do become common, we can expect to see changes not only in our daily lives, but in our environment, and in society as a whole.
