The Cook Islands is proving that environmentally-friendly tourism isn't (1) possible—it's essential. Here's how this South Pacific nation is preserving their islands for future generations.

Landing on Rarotonga, the largest of the Cook Islands, felt like (2) back in time. We immediately noticed the absence of high-rise hotels, fast-food restaurants, and chain stores. There were no traffic lights, only trees (3) the road, the scent of the sea and tropical flowers drifting through the air, and the jungle meeting the ocean. It felt like Hawaii in the 1960s: uncrowded and laid-back.

Our taxi driver pointed to the low buildings along the coast. "No building can be higher than a coconut tree," she said. This isn't simply a local tradition but a law made in 1965 by the Cook Islands' first premier, Albert Henry, to prevent overdevelopment. The taxi driver explained that only Cook Islanders can own land, ensuring that large corporations don't (4) the landscape. We soon learned that this preservation of the natural environment is deeply intentional. Cook Islanders have made an effort to ensure that Rarotonga never becomes a concrete jungle like many of the resorts in Hawaii.

The Cook Islands, a group of 15 islands between New Zealand and Hawaii, has been self-governing since 1965. With a total population of 21,000, the islands are divided into two areas: the Southern Cook Islands, and the remote Northern Cook Islands. Cook Islanders have their own language, with different dialects across the islands.

On arrival at the Rarotongan Beach Resort and Lagoonarium, staff welcomed us with a warm "Kia Orana," a greeting that (5) as "may you live long." It's a unique gesture of friendship from islanders famous for their hospitality and warmth.

As the days passed, we saw how all (6) of everyday life are friendly to the environment. At the Muri Night Market, a popular outdoor dinner option, we watched shop owners prepare island dishes like *ika mata* (raw fish with lime and coconut milk) and *rukau rukau* (vegetable leaves in coconut cream), all using local ingredients. We were impressed by the market's Rent-a-Plate project, where visitors can borrow reusable plates, knives and forks instead of using plastic which would be thrown in the trash after one use. Cook Islanders also (7) clean water initiatives. We purchased reusable bottles from the visitors' centre and refilled them at free water stations around the island, another project designed to minimise plastic waste. We also explored the endless white-sand beaches of the islands. They were all unspoiled. Most had no buildings to obstruct the view.

At Muri Beach, we decided to go on a tour to see some of the creatures living in the sea around the islands. Our guide, Eric, explained the importance of these creatures to the Cook Islands, economically, environmentally, and culturally. Daily tour operators earn an income by taking (8) passengers to see these graceful, curious creatures. Plus, sea creatures are a (9) indicator of the health of the ocean environment, so monitoring and preservation are vital.

By the time our trip had come to an end, we better understood how Cook Islanders have created a model for preserving their home by ancient conservation methods and modern environmental initiatives. As our taxi driver said about the islands, "This is our little paradise; if we all (10) after it, it will remain beautiful forever."
