**[Gungun Class]** (17 lessons) ..... A Saturday course for those who have learned Japanese for a while or taken the Wakuwaku Class.

Eligibility:

- Those who has no Japanese learning experience because of work or childcare
- Those who are living, working or studying in and around Toshima-ku
- Those who are aged 16 and over
- Those who are able to attend every class

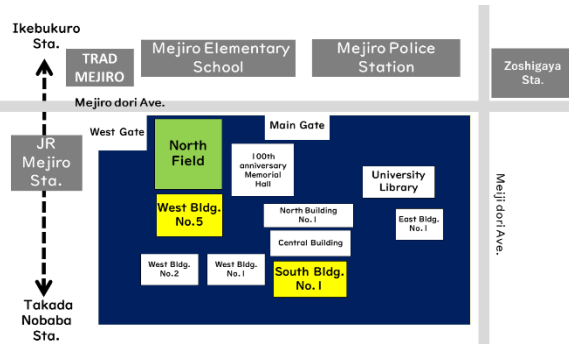

## [Wakuwaku Class] (10 lessons)

A short-term intensive course for beginners in learning Japanese.

- You will be able to have a minimum level of conversations in Japanese required to live in Japan. For example, you will be able to introduce yourself, do some shopping at a grocery store, go through administrative procedures at a city office, and so on.
- Be able to read hiragana and katakana, and to write your own name in katakana.
