Language Requirement	<p>Regarding Japanese language ability, successful candidates must satisfy either of the following requirements in principle</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) have studied Japanese for 2 years or more before coming to Gakushuin 2) have passed the Japanese Language Proficiency Test(JLPT) Level N4 or to have the equivalent ability <p>*If you wish to apply for the Faculty of International Social Sciences, you are required to satisfy either of the following requirements in addition to above Japanese language ability.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) be native speakers of English 2) enrolled in a partner university where English is the major language of instruction

	3) have the proficiency equivalent to 80 on the TOEFL iBT or 6.0 on the IELTS

Financial Support	<p>Gakushuin University Exchange Student Scholarship - Up to 250,000 Japanese yen / year in principle - to those with an outstanding academic record having the minimum of 2.30 GPA, which is calculated using JASSO's GPA calculation method (on a 3.0 scale), based on a transcript from the previous academic year * This scholarship scheme may not be available to those partner universities in which there is an excessive imbalance in the number of exchange students.</p> <p>Gakushuin University Exchange Student Accommodation Grants - up to 50,000 yen/month (25,000 yen for half a month) - to those who stay at Wakeijuku or Kitazono Women's Student Dormitory (see "Accommodation") * Those who receive a scholarship of 100,000 yen/month or higher, or those partner universities in which there is an excessive imbalance in the number of exchange students are not eligible.</p>
