

学習院大学 令和6（2024）年度 協定留学プログラム（第2期） 募集要項

学習院大学国際センター

1. 概要

協定留学プログラムとは、本学が外国の大学と締結した協定をもとに、原則として1年間（一部の大学は半年間）、両大学の学生を交換、あるいは本学学生を協定校へ派遣するプログラムです。

2. 派遣先大学

別紙のとおり ※派遣先大学の動向等に伴い、予告なく内容に変更が生じることがあります。

3. 派遣期間

2024年10月1日～2025年9月30日（1年間）

4. 出願資格

以下のすべての条件を満たす者。

- (1) 心身ともに健康で、本学学生の代表として、所定の留学期間を全うできる者。
- (2) 留学期間終了時まで、本学の正規学生として在籍し、留学期間終了後、本学に戻り、学業を継続する者又は本学の学位を取得する者。
- (3) 国際センターへの学内選考の出願時点で学業成績（GPA）が2.00以上であり、派遣先大学への出願時にもその成績を維持できる見込みの者。なお、留学希望先大学の学業成績基準が上記を上回る場合は、その基準を優先する。
- (4) 国際センターへの学内選考の出願時点で、在籍している学期1学期につき、学部生は15単位以上、大学院生は8単位以上の単位を修得した者または修得する見込みの者。
- (5) 派遣先大学の応募条件に見合う者。
- (6) 保証人の同意が得られる者。

5. 出願書類

- ・「使用言語」の選択が可能な場合は、留学先大学で使用を希望する言語を選択すること。
- ・「語学条件」の欄には、各大学の応募条件に示された語学条件を満たす方法について、以下のうちから該当する番号を選択すること。

①語学能力証明書提出 ②当該語学科目履修済 ③当該語学科目履修中

※第2志望がない場合は、「なし」を選択すること。

※1年生で成績が発表されていない場合は、「なし」と記載すること。

※奨学金の状況は、留学に関する奨学金のみ入力すること。

(2) 申請書（記述）（指定書式）

※指定場所に顔写真を貼付すること。

※第2志望がない場合は1ページ目のみ提出のこと。

(3) G-Port 成績照会ページのプリントアウト（成績証明書は不要）

※1年生で成績が発表されていない者は、現在の履修状況の分かる時間割表を提出すること。

(4) 語学能力を証明する書類のコピー（原本は不可）

※志望先が英語圏以外の場合は、各大学の応募条件に示された語学条件を満たすことを証明する書類を提出すること。上記（1）の

- ①に該当する場合は、語学能力試験のスコア・合格証等、
- ②に該当する場合は、G-Port 成績照会ページのプリントアウト、
- ③に該当する場合は、G-Port 履修科目確認ページのプリントアウトとする。

いずれも、（3）と重複して提出する必要はない。

(5) 推薦状（指定書式）

※この推薦状は、派遣学生として相応しい学生であることを、国際センターに推薦してもらうもので、派遣先大学へ提出するものではない。

※ゼミの指導教員、HRの担当教員など、所属学科の専任教員に依頼すること。

(6) 誓約書（指定書式）

※第2次選考（面接審査）通過者のみ後日提出すること。保証人と事前に内容を確認しておき、署名は、必ず保証人本人にもらうこと。

8. 学内選考方法および結果発表

(1) 書類審査（第1次選考）

結果発表：12月7日（木）12時30分

実施方法：申請書類を元に選考を行う。

発表方法：国際センター内に掲示

(2) 面接審査 (第2次選考)

選考日時：12月11日(月)～15日(金) 12時20分～14時30分又は17時以降(予定)
のいずれかの日時(詳細な日時は第1次選考の結果発表時に指定する)

実施方法：対面(詳細は第1次選考通過者に通知)

選考基準：①留学計画 ②学業成績・語学能力 ③人物・国際性のもと総合的に判断

※授業の時間は考慮したうえで実施日時調整を行う。

※面接は、日本語および派遣先の言語によりグループ面接で行われる。

結果発表：12月末日までに個別に通知する。

9. 本学の授業料

派遣先大学の学費が全額免除される場合は、留学期間中の本学の学費を全額納入する。

派遣先大学の学費が発生する場合は、留学期間中の本学の授業料・施設設備費は、在籍料を除き、免除する。

10. 単位認定 (() 内は大学院学生の場合)

派遣先大学において修得した単位のうち、教授会(研究科委員会)が適当と認めた単位を60単位(10単位)を限度として、本大学において修得したものとして認定される。

11. 留意事項

- ・学内選考後に協定校側から条件変更の通知があった場合には、その条件に見合わない者は派遣を取り消す可能性がある。
- ・災害や国際紛争、感染症の世界的流行等により、予告無しの募集停止や、選考合格後の派遣の中止、又、オンライン留学への変更等が生じる場合がある。
- ・事前に所属学科とよく相談の上、出願すること。
- ・当プログラムによる派遣は、「留学願」を提出し、承認されることが必要である。「休学願」を提出しての渡航は認められない。
- ・当プログラムによる派遣学生は「学習院大学海外留学奨学金」に応募できる。詳細は、HP等で確認すること。
